We are driven by a network of over 4,000 student volunteers and our free online content has been used 1 million times.




Why work with us?

University applications still aren't fair.

State-educated children are 33% less likely to attend top universities than the privately educated. Progression to university differs across the UK, meaning regional inequalities linger across generations.

Accessing word-of-mouth advice can be key to a successful uni application, but it's difficult to find.

Word-of-mouth advice is trusted by applicants, and can be the key factor in creating successful applicants. However, without a way of coordinating alumni, word-of-mouth advice can be difficult to find. This means applicants often miss out on this valuable resource, and resort to less reliable online chatrooms for relatable advice.

We connect schools, MATs, and local authorities with communities of local students to design and deliver bespoke programmes of university application support.

Our programmes include:

- Interactive workshops and discussion seminars led by student ambassadors
- Bespoke application resources designed by our local student ambassadors

Step 1

We co-design the programme with student ambassadors & your school(s)

Step 2

We train and recruit local student ambassadors to lead our workshops

Step 3

Student ambassadors deliver sessions and bespoke application resources to pupils

Step 4

Your pupils join a local, personal network of peer supporters
